Freedom's Wings International (FWI) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization run by and for people with physical disabilities. We provide the opportunity for those who are physically challenged to fly in sailplanes (gliders) specially adapted with hand controls, either as a passenger or as a member of the flight training program.

Freedom's Wings International is an all-volunteer organization utilizing the skills of both disabled and able-bodied members. We welcome the participation of all interested, caring people.

Interested parties are invited to participate in the following:

- Individuals with a disability to take an inspirational glider ride.
- Qualified individuals with a disability to train in Freedom's Wings gliders to earn the FAA private, commercial, or glider flight instructor certificates.
- Individuals to organize and publicize Outreach Events such as the NBC Nightly News report (downloadable from [youtube.com/user/FreedomsWingsInt/videos](https://youtube.com/user/FreedomsWingsInt/videos) ).
- Individuals to write grant proposals funding: Freedom's Wings Outreach Events, procurement of a new fleet of high performance gliders, training scholarships for individuals with disabilities requiring financial assistance.
- Individuals having mechanical engineering education to design improved flight controls systems for individuals with disabilities.
- Individuals to perform clerical functions.
- Able-bodied volunteers to serve as ground crew ("Wing Runners" and glider retrieval) for Freedom's Wings Pilots with disabilities.
- FAA certified glider flight instructors (able-bodied and individuals with disabilities) to volunteer for the glider student flight training program.
